Encouraging Responsible Consumption & Promotion of Green Village concept

The findings revealed that approximately Rs 2 crore worth of food is wasted annually. The primary reasons for this significant waste include people taking more food than they can consume, excessive food preparation, improper serving methods, and the involvement of unprofessional cooks. Addressing these issues is essential for reducing food waste and fostering a more sustainable community.
